The Epistle 2 Timothy 3:10-15

Timothy, my son, you have observed my teaching, my conduct, my aim in life, my faith, my patience, my love, my steadfastness, my persecutions, my sufferings, what befell me at Antioch, at Iconion, and at Lystra, what persecutions I endured; yet from them all the Lord rescued me. Indeed all who desire to live a godly life in Christ Jesus will be persecuted, while evil men and impostors will go on from bad to worse, deceivers and deceived. But as for you, continue in what you have learned and have firmly believed, knowing from whom you learned it and how from childhood you have been acquainted with the sacred writings which are able to instruct you for salvation through faith in Christ Jesus.

The Gospel Luke 18:10-14

The Lord said this parable, "Two men went up into the temple to pray, one a Pharisee and the other a tax collector. The Pharisee stood and prayed thus with himself, 'God, I thank you that I am not like other men, extortioners, unjust, adulterers, or even like this tax collector. I fast twice a week, I give tithes of all that I get.' But the tax collector, standing far off, would not even lift up his eyes to heaven, but beat his breast, saying, 'God, be merciful to me a sinner!' I tell you, this man went down to his house justified rather than the other; for everyone who exalts himself will be humbled, but he who humbles himself will be exalted."

 - Collected children and adult winter coats that were donated to Repeat Boutique and also purchased children and adult coats that were donated to Warm Coats for Kool Kids and to Midwest Shelter for Homeless Veterans (also donated hats, gloves, scarves);
 - o Made adult sized fleece blankets for the BEDS Plus service project;
 - o Collected funds to purchase Christmas gifts for the Metropolitan Family Services Holiday Shoppe;
 - o Provided support to several families facing challenging circumstances;
 - o Prepared and distributed sack lunches at Annunciation Cathedral for Feed the Hungry program;
 - O Donated funds to Fashion Show beneficiaries Easter Seals DuPage and Fox Valley and CrossRoads Institute, Archdiocese of Korea Foundation, Orthodox Christian Prison Ministry, Greek Orthodox Archdiocese for Hurricane Relief, Stuffed Love, a 5th Saturday service project, Mission of Love and Hope, Fanari to fund two 2025 summer camp scholarships, Feed My Starving Children and St. Basil's Church Philoptochos for their Dress-A-Girl/Boy Sew-a-Thon.
