Second place went to Anthony Milak, Jacob San Luis took third, his brother Rafael finished fourth and Stefanie Milak, the top female finisher, was fifth. After the feature race, several younger children competed in a few shorter races, either on foot or scooter. These future runners put on quite a show. 
The Gospel – Matthew 4:18-23




